Local note: county commissions is partisan, try to get it moved to nonpartisan, good place to start with local political scene

Positive feedback at union rally on Monday noted that there are Rs interested in a common issue, joining a traditional Dem issue, looking at issues in a right/wrong stand rather than a half right, diverse views expressed in speeches by various union groups

Working with EOU Dems and/or Alliance for Social Change

Targeting 2012 elections

Suggestion – have them involved with some sort of project before campaign time

Maybe need more time to plan social hour (maybe May 4th or 6th is too soon) Choose some sort of focus for gathering, such as fundraising for party or cookies for troops, Political Junkie trivia meeting, spelling bee at a bar, create events

Continue to actively recruit and brainstorm events, fundraising ideas, build relationships with constituents
